

**Osarus Posts 2014 Gains:**

French sales company Osarus ended their 2014 sales season with a 25.5% rise in annual turnover of €5,858,750 compared to €4,683,000 in 2013. Their four sales offered 677 lots with 508 sold for a clearance rate of 75%. MAB Agency was the top buyer scooping up 18 lots for €454,000. The leading vendor was Haras de Grandcamp who sold 28 lots for €429,500.
